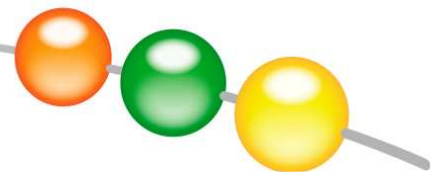
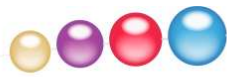

### **INLPTA or ANLP: Which is best for me?**

**INLPTA** is the International NLP Trainers Association and is an international co-operative association of aligned NLP Trainers and Master Trainers who have agreed to abide by and uphold INLPTA's standards of quality, professionalism and ethics in their NLP accreditation training and in the conduct of their NLP business.

**ANLP** is the only independent organisation with an established public reputation for promoting standards, professionalism and good practice in NLP. ANLP is a Community Interest Company, a `Not for Profit` organisation which exists for the benefit of the NLP and Coaching Community. The Mission of ANLP is to collectively make a positive difference to society by encouraging Practitioners to deliver NLP in a professional, responsible and congruent way.

All members are governed by the ANLP Code of Ethics and abide by our membership Terms and Conditions.

The essential difference between the two paths is the length of time you spend in formal training. INLPTA require a Practitioner of NLP to have completed a minimum 130 hours of formal face to face training with an INLPTA Certified Trainer of NLP. ANLP recognise a range of different approaches to becoming certified as a practitioner. Our alternative is to combine a mix of distance learning and formal face to face training. This combination provides the same number of hours as the INLPTA path, split into 72 hours of distance learning and 65 hours of formal face to face training.

Your choice will depend upon your preferred learning style. With the ANLP path you will complete the distance learning (content knowledge) in the months leading up to your practitioner programme. The 10 days will be intensive and a fast pace will be maintained - the emphasis of the 10 days is very much on experiential learning. The INLPTA path blends the theoretical and experiential into everyday - the pace may be a bit slower, the content will be taught to a high level. In between the modules you will be expected to complete some assignments. Each path will require the completion of a written integration paper prior to certification.
